The campaign aims to collect One Million pencils to be given to underprivileged students in elementary schools of 4th and 6th class Municipalities and set a Guinness Book of World Record for the longest line of pencils.

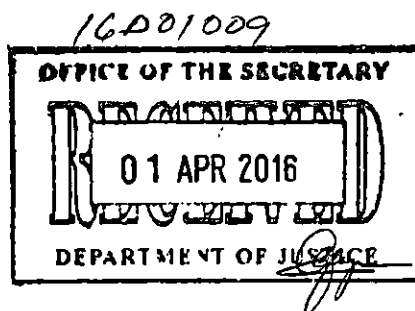
The **Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC)** is the focal government inter-agency body mandated to formulate policies and plans, monitor the implementation and enforcement of laws to protect and promote children's rights by virtue of Presidential Decree 603, otherwise known as the Child and Youth Welfare Code.

In the area of advocacy and promotion of children's rights, CWC leads in the celebration of special events on children such as the Children's Month celebration, National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Exploitation and Protection and Gender-Fair Treatment of the Girl-Child Week.

For 2016, CWC will embark its advocacy project entitled "**One Million Lapis**". The 1M Lapis campaign aims to collect One Million pencils to be given to underprivileged students in elementary schools of 4th to 6th Municipalities and set a Guinness Book of World Record for the longest line of Lapis. The Campaign Project was launched in November 2016 during the Zumbata kick-off of the 2015 National Children's Month at SM SkyDome, SM North EDSA in partnership with the Department of Education, SM Cares and SM Supermalls.

As an update for the Project, we were able to get the commitment of SM Supermalls and National Bookstore for the 300T Lapis and 50T Lapis, respectively. We also enrolled the Longest Line of Lapis for the Guinness of World Records as part of the 2016 National Children's Month celebration.

In line with the above, **may we seek the help of DOJ and its regional offices for the collection of Lapis**. CWC will provide the drop-box to be installed in the DOJ Central Office. May we likewise request that you facilitate the drop-boxes in your respective Regional Offices. The Lapis drop-boxes will be collected every two months or if already filled will be coordinated to CWC. The Armed Forces of the Philippines will do the transportation of collected Lapis from origin of drop-boxes location to DepEd Central Office at ULTRA, Pasig City.
