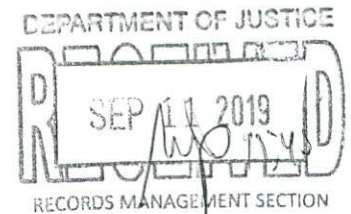

1. This is to provide, for your advance information, the attached JDS Flyer for Japanese Academic Year (AY) 2020-2022 which contains details on the application period for the 2-year Master's Degree program covering AY 2020 and 2021, and 3-year Ph.D. program covering AY2020 to AY2022 under the subject Program being supported by a grant from the Government of Japan. Since its inception in 2003, more than 300 fellows from different Philippine Government agencies and organizations have been dispatched to various prestigious Japanese universities through the JDS Project.
2. Twenty (20) fellows from various Philippine Government agencies will be dispatched in AY2020 to undertake master's degree programs while two (2) will be dispatched to take doctoral degree programs in Japanese universities.
3. The tentative deadline for submission of the candidates' nominations with their application documents is **on November 4, 2019**.¹ Kindly note the following important reminders:

Vecina) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) – International Affairs Office (c/o Director Lily Freida T. Macabangun-Milla), respectively; and,
 - c. Late submission and incomplete application documents will NOT be accepted.
