MEMORANDUM FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

**TO : ALL DEPARTMENT SECRETARIES AND HEADS OF AGENCIES,
GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND/OR CONTROLLED
CORPORATIONS (GOCCs) AND GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL
INSTITUTIONS (GFIs)**

**SUBJECT : TRAVELS TO CANADA ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS AND OFFICIAL
INTERACTION WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CANADIAN
GOVERNMENT**

DATE : 20 May 2019

In light of the continuing failure of the Canadian Government to retrieve the containers of garbage unlawfully shipped to the Philippines, and to emphasize even further the seriousness of our Government's demands with regard to the same, all concerned officials are directed to:

1. Refrain from issuing travel authorities for official foreign trips to Canada, to the officers and personnel of their respective departments and attached agencies; and
2. Reduce official interaction of their respective departments and agencies with representatives of the Canadian Government.

This directive shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until further notice.
