

## **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

### **Production of Video for the Global Virtual Summit**

Background: The Philippines has been dubbed as the global epicenter for live streamed abuse of children, but unknown to the general public is the Philippine government's effort to address this issue. Since 2011, Philippine law enforcement has conducted 149 rescue operations that have resulted in 512 victims and children-at-risk removed from online abuse. These survivors are in various stages of restoration through the services provided by the Philippine's Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and private aftercare institutions. In addition to these rescue operations, Philippine prosecutors have achieved 66 convictions perpetrators in court, to date. There have also been community-based awareness and prevention activities conducted by various government agencies and private stakeholders. Through these initial successes, the team has developed effective practices that can be shared and replicated nationally and globally, helping local stakeholders and other foreign governments address the emergence of this crime in their respective jurisdictions.

Due to the realities brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, hosting a global conference to showcase the realities of OSEC in the Philippines and what the government and private sector are doing to combat it is not feasible at this point.

A global virtual dialogue on OSEC serves as fitting and timely.
