MECHANICS AND CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

DIGITAL POSTER-MAKING CONTEST IN CELEBRATION OF WORLD COMPETITION DAY

Theme: "Competition Policy for an Inclusive and Resilient Economy"

A. MECHANICS

1. The Digital Poster-Making Contest, as one of the activities for the annual observance of World Competition Day, is open to all DOJ Employees nationwide, including contractual, temporary, and job order personnel.

The Office for Competition (OFC) shall constitute the panel of judges who will choose the winners ranking 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, with prizes of Eight Thousand Pesos (Php8,000.00), Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00), and Three Thousand (Php3,000.00), respectively.

2. Participants may use photoshop, paint, or any digital drawing software or application.
3. All entries must be consistent to the theme provided, original, and not have been previously published.
4. An entry must follow the specifications below:

Size: A4 bond paper
Format: PDF or JPEG/JPG

5. Soft copies must be submitted to dojofc.ph@gmail.com.
6. Deadline for the e-mail submission of the entries for judging will be **on or before 03 December 2021, until 5:00pm only**.
7. All entries will be posted in the Official Facebook Page of the DOJ.
8. Announcement of winners will be on **10 December 2021 and posted on the DOJ Official Facebook page**. The winners will also be informed through e-mail.

B. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

All entries will be judged based on the following criteria:

• Theme Relevance	-	40%
• Originality	-	30%
• Creativity	-	30%
Total	:	100%
