WHEREAS, CD Technologies Asia, Inc. submitted a quotation for the said subscription to the Lex Libris Bulletins and Network Licenses for CY 2021 in the total amount of One Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Two Pesos (₱ 177,352.00);

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Department of Justice – Bids and Awards Committee **RESOLVES**, as it hereby resolve, to **RECOMMEND** the confirmation of resort to alternative mode of procurement of Direct Contracting, and further recommend the award of contract to **CD Technologies Asia, Inc.**, as the creator, publisher, and copyright owner of the electronic publications on CD-ROM, DVD-ROM, and online, the renewal of subscription to the Lex Libris Bulletins and Network Licenses for CY 2021, in the total amount of **ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO PESOS (₱ 177,352.00)**, following the procedures prescribed in R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.
