RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE RENEWAL OF THE AGENCY-TO-AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PHILIPPINE POSTAL CORPORATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 2022 TO DECEMBER 2022

WHEREAS, there is a need for the delivery of the Department of Justice's (DOJ) mail matters, both international and domestic, including registered and express mail, which are all impressed with public interest being intimately connected with the proper administration of justice;

WHEREAS, the procurement/engagement of the services of Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPOST) is included in the approved CY-2022 Indicative Annual Procurement Plan with an allotted budget of Fifteen Million Three Hundred Eight Thousand Pesos (₱15,308,000.00) and is part of the Department's early procurement activities;

WHEREAS, the PHLPOST was created pursuant to Republic Act No. 7354 or the Postal Service Act of 1992, and is the only government-owned and controlled corporation mandated by law to engage in the business of carrying and delivering mails, with the requisite capacity to perform such mandate;

WHEREAS, the engagement of PHLPOST by DOJ falls within the Negotiated procurement of Agency-to-Agency, an alternative mode of procurement under the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. No. 9184. Section 53.5 provides:

53.5. Agency-to-Agency. Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services from another agency of the GoP, such as DBM-PS, which is tasked with a centralized procurement of Common-Use-Supplies for the GoP in accordance with Letters of Instruction No. 755 and E.O. 359, s. 1989.

WHEREAS, the DOJ indicated and authorized Agency-to-Agency procurement for its postage and courier services, including mails and freight/hauling

services, considering that the same is more efficient, economical, and most advantageous to the DOJ;

WHEREAS, based on the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between DOJ and PHLPOST, the former will pay the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (₱15,000,000.00) for the mail matters of the Department for the period January 2022 to December 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Department of Justice – Bids and Awards Committee **RESOLVES**, as it hereby resolved, to **RECOMMEND** the renewal of Agency-to-Agency Agreement between the **DOJ and PHLPOST**, for the delivery of the Department's mail matters, both international and domestic, including registered and express mail, for the period January 2022 to December 2022, in the amount of **FIFTEEN MILLION PESOS (₱15,000,000.00)**, following the procedures prescribed in R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.
