RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO THE MANILA TIMES FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE 2019 REVISED IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10592

WHEREAS, there is a need for the publication of the 2019 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10592 (R.A. No. 10592);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6, Rule XIII of the 2019 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 10592, it was provided that:

“Rule III Section 6. Effectivity Clause

These Rules shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the date of publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.

WHEREAS, the procurement of the publication in two (2) newspapers in general circulation is included in the CY2019 Supplemental Annual Procurement Plan No. 2 (SAPP No. 2), with an allotted budget of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Pesos (P130,000.00);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the rules on *Negotiated Procurement-Procedures for Scientific, Scholarly, or Artistic Work, Exclusive Technology and Media Services*¹, the Procurement Management Division conducted a market study to the following entities, namely: The Manila Times, Abante Tonite, Philippine Manila Standard Publishing Inc., The Philippine Star, Philippine Journal, Sun Star Philippines, and The Manila Bulletin;

WHEREAS, in response to the said invitation, four (4) out of seven (7) prospective bidders, submitted their quotations, to wit,

WHEREAS, after evaluation by the BAC through its Technical Working Group, it shows that The Manila Times is legally, financially, and technically capable to undertake the said procurement.

WHEREAS, the result of the quotations submitted shows that The Manila Times submitted the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (LCRQ);

WHEREAS, considering that the amount involved in the subject procurement is **FIFTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY FOUR PESOS (P53,424.00)**, an alternative mode of procurement is allowed by GPRA, provided, that the amount shall not exceed the thresholds prescribed in Annex "H" of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Bids and Award Committee **RESOLVES**, as it hereby resolve, to **RECOMMEND** the approval of Scientific, Scholarly or Artistic Work, Exclusive Technology and Media Services as an alternative mode of procurement, and the award of contract to **The Manila Times** for the publication of the 2019 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 10592 in the amount of **FIFTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY FOUR PESOS (P53,424.00)**, following the procedures prescribed in R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.
