

## INVITATION TO BID

The Department of Justice (DOJ), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is inviting interested contractors with Size Range of Small "B" and License Category of "C" & "D" to bid for hereunder project:

Name of Project : Repair and Improvement of Various DOJ Offices

Location : Department of Justice

Approved Budget for the Contract : ₱ 1,168,571.56

Contract Duration : 60 calendar days

The prospective bidders must have an experience of having completed at least one (1) contract similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current price using PSA consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC to be bid. The Eligibility Check/ Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids shall use non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria. Post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid shall be conducted.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-bidding Conference, Evaluation of Bids, Post-Qualification and Award of contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 dated 28 October 2016.
