RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO RAMERSON OFFICE FURNITURE INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS MODULAR PARTITION FOR DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ)

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice (DOJ) posted its Invitation to Bid for the purchase of various modular partition for Department of Justice (DOJ) PhilGEPS, DOJ Website, bulletin boards of Manila City Hall, and Department of Justice, continuously for a minimum of seven (7) days;

WHEREAS, in response to the said invitation, two (2) prospective bidders purchased the bid documents namely: Distinctive Blinds and Office Systems, Inc. (Distinctive); and Ramerson Office Furniture Inc. (Ramerson);

WHEREAS, in a public bidding held on 27 December 2017 at 10:00 a.m. at Room 313 conference room of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Chairperson, 3rd floor, De Las Alas Hall (formerly DOJ Main Bldg.), both Distinctive and Ramerson passed the preliminary evaluation of the bid requirements;

WHEREAS, after the conduct of the bidding, the bid documents were referred to the Technical Working Group (TWG)/Secretariat of the BAC for post-qualification and evaluation of the bids;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) under bidding is ₱2,180,000.00;

WHEREAS, the result of the evaluation by the TWG is as follows:

WHEREAS, upon evaluation by the BAC-TWG, it appears that Distinctive was post-disqualified due to non-compliance with the required technical specifications pertaining to the thickness of the work top table and panel partition, as per attached post-qualification evaluation report last December 28, 2017;

WHEREAS, the calculated bid in the amount of ₱1,440,800.00 is 33.91% below the ABC, and with its compliance to the required technical specifications, Ramerson was found to have post-qualified with all the legal, technical and financial requirements. Therefore, Ramerson is considered to be the winning bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid;

WHEREAS, the BAC-TWG/Secretariat has recommended the award of the contract in favor of Ramerson in its calculated bid of ₱1,440,800.00;

WHEREAS, the BAC, after further evaluation, finds the recommendation of the BAC TWG/Secretariat to award the contract in favor of Ramerson in the total amount of ₱1,440,800.00 to be reasonable and most advantageous to the government;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Bids and Awards Committee, after a thorough deliberation, resolves, as it hereby **RESOLVE** to recommend the **GRANT** of the award of contract to Ramerson Office Furniture Inc. for the purchase of various modular partition for Department of Justice (DOJ), in the total amount of **ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (₱1,440,800.00)**.
