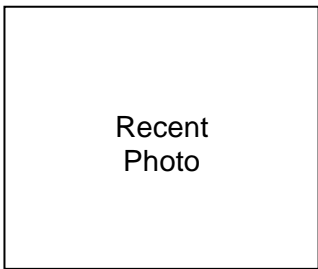

- Resolution/Information (for rape / TIP / OSAEC / CSAEM)
- For KIA**, Certificate of Legal Beneficiaries/Declaration of Legal Beneficiaries (authenticated copy)
- For WIA**, Certificate (wounded) with journal (authenticated copy)
- Government issued ID / Barangay Certificate with Picture

E. VICTIMS OF ENFORCED OR INVOLUNTARY DISAPPEARANCE AND/OR THEIR IMMEDIATE RELATIVES. (REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10353)

*Submit the **Original or Certified True Copies** of any of the following record/s:*

- NPS Resolution
- CHR Resolution
- Record of the National Historical Institute (NHI) or the Bantayog ng mga Bayani Memorial Center
- Writ of Amparo, Habeas Corpus and Habeas Data or Court Order
- Roll of victims of enforced or involuntary disappearance officially issued subsequently by the government
- Government issued ID / Barangay Certificate with picture

13. **If claimant is an HEIR**, he/she shall submit the **Original or Certified True Copy** of the following document/s:

- Marriage Certificate if claimant is the spouse of the victim
- Birth Certificate if claimant is a child / parent of the victim
- Proof of relationship of claimant to victim (e.g. spouse, sibling, grandparent, parent)
- Barangay Certificate
- Special Power of Attorney
- Government issued ID / Barangay Certificate with picture
