Prosecutor V	He/ she must be a natural born citizen of the Philippines	Must be at least forty (40) years of age	Must have been, for at least fifteen (15) years, a judge of a court of records or has been engaged in the practice of law in the Philippines or has held office requiring admission to the Bar as an requisite for a like period
Prosecutor IV	He/ she must be a natural born citizen of the Philippines	Must be at least thirty five (35) years of age	Must have been, for at least ten (10) years, engaged in the practice of law in the Philippines requiring admission in the practice of law as an indispensable requisite
Prosecutor I - III	He/ she must be a natural born citizen of the Philippines	Must be at least thirty (30) years of age	Must have been, for at least five (5) years engaged in the practice of law in the Philippines or has held public office in the Philippines, requiring admission in the practice of law as an indispensable requisite
